The "BIG" Picture



Tech Serve believes in serving by connecting volunteers and ministries to mission projects worldwide, once connected, the big picture can be achieved. Tech Serve partners with many ministries, recently we have partnered with the BMAA (Baptist Missionary Association of America) for shipping, logistics, and warehouses services. One of the main uses for this warehouse is to store project materials such as Bibles, medicals supplies, and other project materials like 12,222 shoeboxes. Mr. Jim Highland organized and worked very hard along with the help of dozens of BMAA volunteers to collect, manage, pack, count, load, and store these shoeboxes. Tech Serve loaded two containers (about 6,100 shoeboxes/container) which were shipped to the countries of Romania (eastern Europe) and Jordan (Middle East), where they will be distributed by the BMA missionaries. Special about the Jordan container is that the BMA missionaries plan to give many of the shoeboxes to Syrian refugees.

A Full Circle...

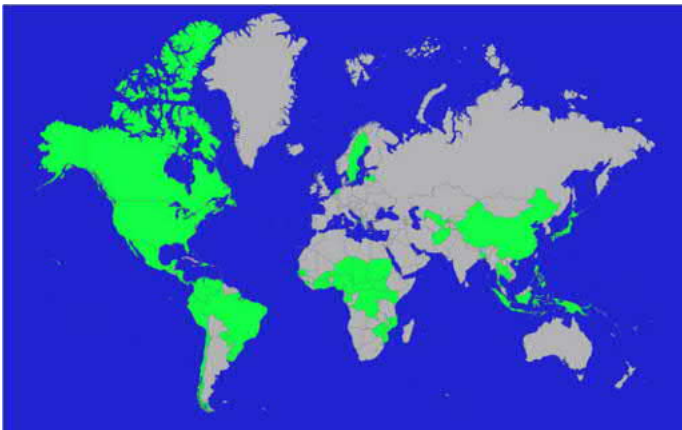
In 1985 Wes Syverson went to *Abidjan, Ivory Coast* to install a telephone system for the new SIL/Wycliffe Bible Translators Office building. The system was a 1A2 Key system and provided working phones throughout the building, four floors of offices, apartments, and translation conference rooms. At the time Wes was head of the Utilities Dept. at Wycliffe Associates, providing Wycliffe sites with Water, Electric, and Telephone systems and services. Pictured with Wes are Dave Beatty, Otto Witchert, and Cloyd McCauley. As Tech Serve, Wes continued to provide parts and service through out West Africa, for many decades.



30 years later in September 2015, Weston (Wes's son) made the trip to Abidjan to the same building with a brand new system in his luggage, along with patch panels, telephones, Wi-Fi access points, and supplies to install. In two weeks Weston and the national team installed the system and wired the building for telephone and data. This system was installed entirely on patch panels making moves and changes simple with patch cords. Weston also spent time training Laurel, Julie, Arno, Ambroise, Pierre, and Kofi on wiring and system administration.

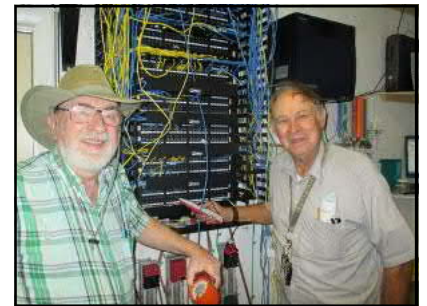


How many countries are in the **WORLD**?

Earl Nickelson and Larry Wall working on DSL implementation for 60 retirement homes at New Tribes Homes in Sanford Florida.

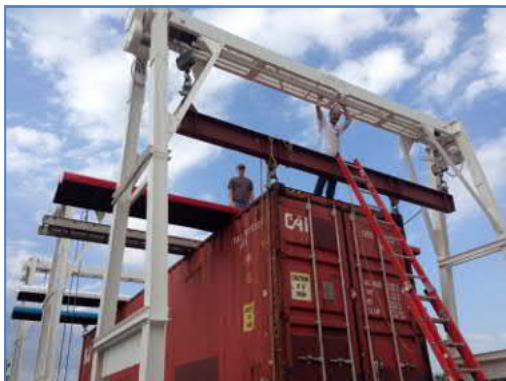


Darryl & Anita McGinty built and painted all the cabinets for the missionary house to be built in Papua New Guinea.
