In the busy town of La Entrada, **Honduras**, the **Manos Amigas Clinic** is a welcoming refuge for the needy: here, people without means can receive medical care from professionals at *a reduced rate or zero cost*. This is **unexpected** for the local people who now have access to professional care where virtually none existed before.

At a fraction of the normal cost, Tech Serve *Volunteers* built a state of the art clinic for **Clínica Fundación Manos Amigas** in partnership with **Serving at the Crossroads** several years ago. This effort was partly funded by Honduran businessmen who see its value for the people. At this location, **the poor are cared for**, and Honduran doctors receive training in advanced medical procedures. Since its construction, medical needs in the clinic have grown to necessitate a **large addition** to provide for eye surgeries.

On Site in Honduras

For over a year, **Wes Syverson** has been designing, calculating costs, and scheduling to build this addition. Volunteer **Darrell McGinty** is an answer to prayer, working with Wes in the office to purchase materials and finish site plans on time. This summer, volunteer **Larry Zaugg** traveled to La Entrada to break ground — Larry was able to layout and pour the 60 by 60 foot *concrete slab* with the help of the *local Hondurans*.

In July, Tech Serve received the *red iron steel* to build the addition.
