



Some great things are happening in Sierra Leone! For many years 4 H.I.M. (His Healing Helping Hands International Ministries) has worked along side existing church leaders to promote the Good News of Jesus Christ around the world. In Sierra Leone, 4HIM partners with Great Harvest to operate a Pineapple Juice factory, to fund and empower local churches and ministries. Tech Serve has been privileged to work with 4HIM for many years. Recently, TSI designed, shipped, and helped construct a large building to house the Juice factory. TSI's Weston Syverson and Dale Jones accompanied 4HIMs superintendent John Allison to erect the building. The steel structure is 150 feet long by 50 feet wide and is strong enough to support solar panels on the roof to provide power for the factory. TSI has shipped two more containers with supplies, including a forklift and 288 solar panels for the project.

.. On an earlier trip John had completed the slab, and when the crew arrived the building was still inside of the containers. Weston, Dale, and John began working with the local workers to teach them how to erect and secure the steel structure, as well as the siding and roofing. All of these construction methods were new to the locals, yet the crew learned rapidly, took over the work, and did a great job!

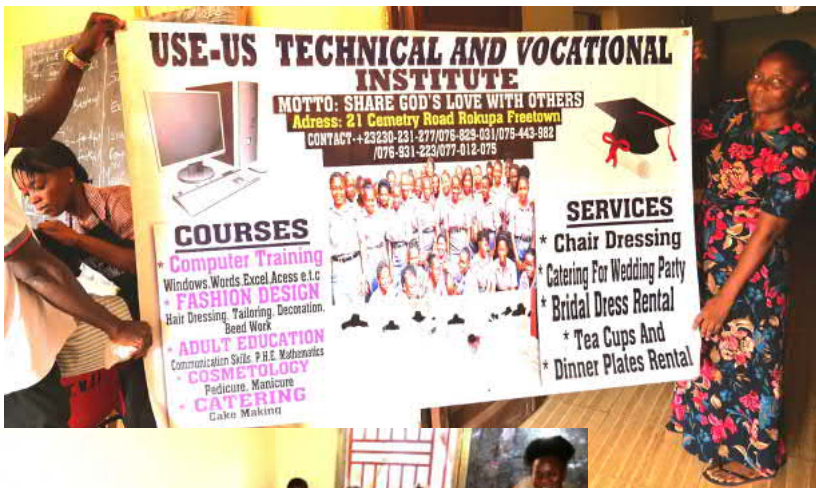




The Crew



One of the ministries that is supported by Great Harvest is a Technical and Vocational school. The director has a love for the local women, many of whom have walked away, or escaped from damaging life choices. The school teaches them how to cook, cut hair, use computers, and learn sewing.





Dressmaking helps to support the school, and cooking a wide variety of food provides the women a chance to learn many skills.

Their moto is "Share God's Love with Others!"



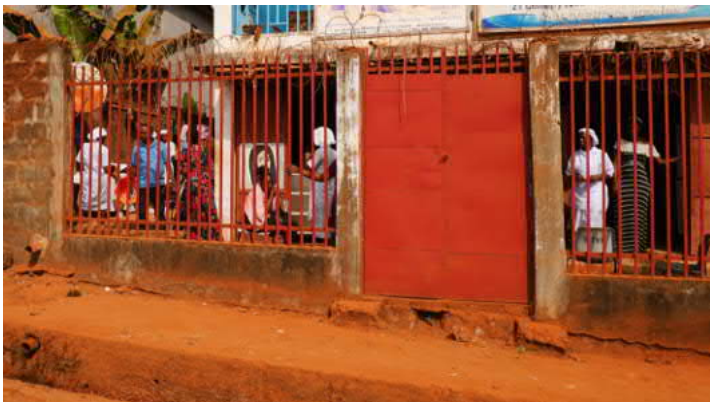


The instructor (left) trains the women in Math, Accounting, Office software, and basic computer skills.

The school is attended by 60—80 students, crammed into 4 tiny classrooms, and an outside area for cooking. They are renting the first floor of a very old building, which is slowly collapsing. The search is on for a more permanent location where the building can meet the needs. If you would like to help financially, please let us know.

Tech Serve has been able to send older laptop computers loaded with educational videos, including mathematics, science, English, and Bible teaching. We are always looking for older laptops to send to Africa, so if you have some send them our way for repurposing. :)

In the near future, this school is planning to add vocational trades for men which will teach carpentry, welding, and other skills. Please pray for the USE-US school in Freetown to have what they need to succeed! In addition, pray for 4 HIM and Great Harvest as they work enabling local ministries in many countries.
