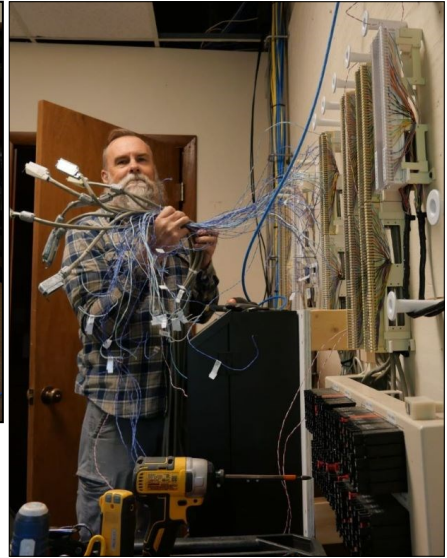
Summer 2025



One of the services Tech Serve provides to ministries around the world is teaching and training in areas of phones, fiber and network technology. With God's help TSI provides installation of complete VOIP telephone systems, hosted VOIP, fiber optic cable installation, network and WiFi systems, as well as training in all of these areas for many youth camps, conference centers, offices, hospitals and schools. Recently Weston installed a VOIP phone system at Young Life's Windy Gap, located in North Carolina in the heart of the Blue Ridge Mountains. Hurricane Helena damaged much of the area in and around the camp, with many tragic consequences. This made summer preparation difficult for the staff. TSI has helped Windy Gap for over 30 years, and this is the 4th system upgrade. Each summer camp needs infrastructure to be able to operate and provide services to their guests. 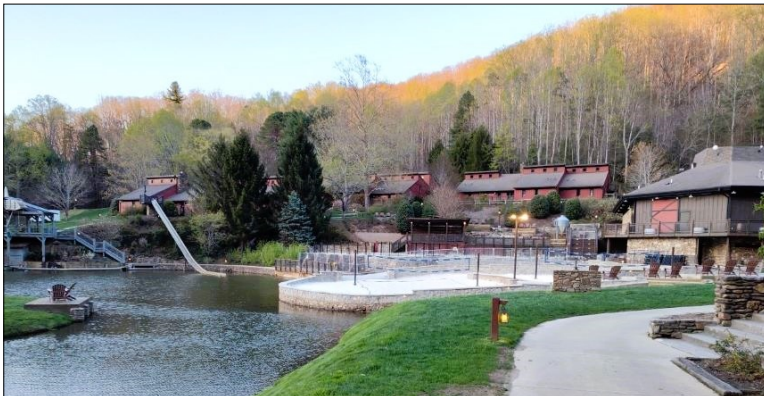

Young Life staff Gary and Russell worked with Weston, installing a new VOIP (voice over internet protocol) phone system. The team slowly replaced the old

phones with the new ones, and after a few days the project was complete! VOIP phone systems offer a modern method of connection using the Ethernet/LAN (Local Area Network) and WiFi for connectivity. This allows for the system to take advantage of the benefits of the computer network, and ease of programming. Weston also trained the office personnel on use and programming for voicemail and mobile apps, as well as the auto attendant functions.





In the heart of central Florida, you will find Young Life's Southwind camp and retreat center. Besides the normal Young Life camps, in the off season you can find fun, adventure, life changing and skill building experiences with many outside activities. TSI Volunteer Tom and Weston worked with YL staff Jeff to install a new VOIP phone system. TSI volunteers installed the original phone system years ago, and after many years of lightning and various damages. It was time for a new VOIP system, using the Network to move the facility into modern technology!



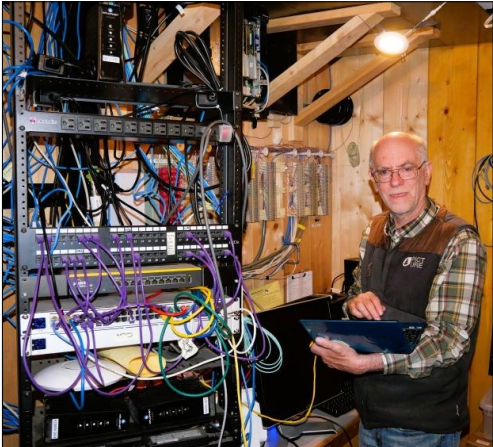


Located in British Columbia, Young Life's camp Malibu is one of the oldest Young Life facilities, and is accessible only by boat. To get there Campers ride on the Malibu Princess! Traveling to train local staff on the various phone and IT systems in place, Weston received the "full camper experience" by arriving with a group of students coming to encounter a deeper walk with God. He was joined by Peter, a local volunteer.

Peter is a gifted volunteer that pours his talents and time into helping with the hydro unit, as well as many networking connections. Together Weston and Peter fixed many items, installed new WiFi access points, and trained on networking and the telephone system. With some staff changes in the last few years there were many systems that needed attention and people to train on taking care of them.



Phone training and network training allows Tech Serve to empower those we serve to do their jobs more efficiently. With God's help, Tech Serve is able to assist many local staff who are serving at many facilities around the world, by providing them with the technology to make their jobs easier. Understanding and having proficiency with your facilities systems is a must for many ministries, and we are privileged to be able to provide training and knowledge for many. WiFi Project Update

With God's help, Tech Serve has been able to place 4 more new WIFI units. Mickeal and Sharon are serving as missionaries in Africa, and are dedicated to helping people and bringing the Good News. There are over 500 villages in their local area, with many smaller villages with just 50-75 people that are not officially recognized. Even these are still part of this vast area in need of education and the Good News of Jesus.



At our offices in Greenbrier, Kent spent time training Mickeal and Sharon to install the units. The simple system runs optimized on a laptop Linux server. Users connect via WIFI and get a simple menu where they can select categories to scroll thousands of videos to watch. In addition to all of the educational videos there are many children's videos and also Biblical movies like the Jesus Film. Content of the units is based on the area to which they are being dispatched and the language of the recipients. We were also able to provide two additional laptops for children to watch the videos on TV Screens in their school. We have had many good reports from the systems installed, with many people spending time watching the educational and Christian videos to learn. It's so good to hear that the message of Jesus is spreading across the globe, even through cell phones! If you are interested in sponsoring a system for a village, the cost of the laptop, radio, and antenna is about \$500. Please continue to pray with us for the success of this project, that many may hear the Good News!
