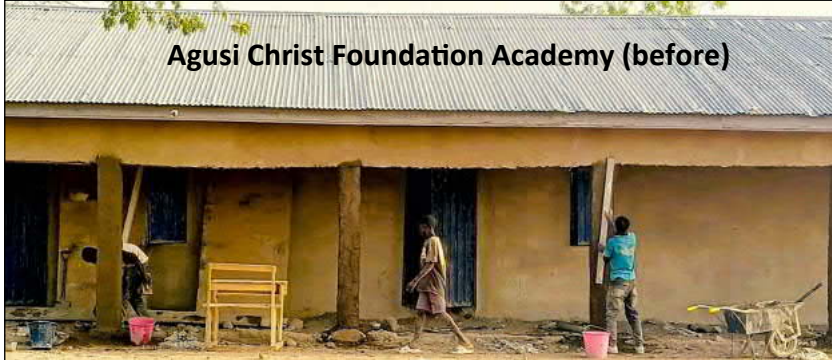
The crew faced a few challenges - lots of rain, mud, and conduit friction. One section of the fiber crossed a 100 year old private trussell bridge!

Construction Project in Ghana

One of the alternative methods of construction that Tech Serve uses for some projects is to use local contractors and local building materials. This is another way to provide the structures ministries need, while reducing both construction costs and construction time.



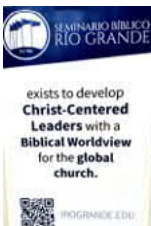
Bids and project time schedules are submitted for approval. This approach enables us to construct local buildings at a fraction of the cost and put the money into local hands. Project phases are completed in accordance with the construction plan and budget.

Tech Serve remotely provides the project oversight and building expertise, to provide a good structure and benefit the local community. In addition to a building, Tech Serve is also providing technological tools to present the gospel message and enrich educational development through our video learning project.
